Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Not For Love - Too Fast to Catch by Nice Catch. Trainer Keefe L. Timothy. Bred by Dark Hollow Farm & Herringswell Stable(MD).

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH cleared early, controlled the pace under nice rating, entered the lane two wide, responded and widened the advantage when set down soon after, kept on under constant left handed pressure and drifted out a bit late. ROMANCING THE GOLD bobbed at the break but quickly recovered, stalked the winner two to three wide, was pushed along mid way on the final turn and stayed on well to be clear for place. WILD LOUIS , taken to rate off the early pace, edged up off the rail after a half mile, progressed between rivals mid way on the final turn, angled out some for the drive and continued on with interest to close the gap. BIG BRANCH , brushed at the break, was angled off the rail entering the backstretch, stalked three to four wide, gave hard chase around the final turn and into the lane and kept on trying to the wire. TALK SHOW MAN stumbled badly at the break, bumped and steadied back soon after, was taken well wide for the backstretch run, gained some near the five eighths pole, circled five wide into the lane, angled in near the three sixteenths pole but could not threaten late. SEVENTEENOHsix leaned in and hit the gate, brushed with BIG BRANCH soon after, secured the inside around the first turn to stalk the pace, came under pressure leaving the far turn, failed to respond and weakened. COUNT TO SEVEN bobbed and bumped at the break then failed to menace.
