CRACKALACKIN well rated early, sat patient to mid turn, asked at the three eighths pole, quickly gained on duelers at the quarter pole, came three wide to head PREACHIN MAN entering the stretch, drove clear mid stretch and increased advantage under steady handling. PREACHIN MAN sent from the gate, dueled outside of YONEGWA down the backside, these two hooked up setting a blistering early pace, edged clear at the quarter pole, headed by the winner top of the stretch, fought gamely to the eighth pole, proved no match late, held place position in a very solid effort. ROBBING THE BANK stalked a contested pace from the start, asked on the turn, angled four wide into the lane, failed to menace top pair. MR. FLAMBOYANT unhurried early, saved ground to top of the lane, swung six wide upper stretch, improved placing but was no real threat. GREGORY'S TRICK lacked speed, gained some momentum near the quarter pole, swung wide into the lane, mildly gained in the drive, no real factor. POW WOW POWER was outrun in the early going, raced wide throughout, swung widest under left handed stick upper stretch, beat weary foes, no factor. YONEGWA sent hard, vied along the rail to the quarter pole, began to weaken in upper stretch, had little left by the furlong marker. GENUINE JUSTICE stalked down the backside, began to chase on the turn, gave way at the quarter pole. BRAVE KNIGHT raced evenly in the second flight, dropped off mid turn, well beaten. D WISE GUY always outrun, never involved.
