COMMUNIQUE raced to the rail, swung out wide for the drive, wore down her rivals and was clear late. KISS WITH A TWIST saved ground, angled out in the second turn, had a brief lead and held place. CIAO was slow early, angled out seven wide and made a late gain. LEMON CHIFFON was wide early, moved to the leader in the second turn but was not good enough. BALLYMORE LADY was unhurried early, waited for room in the second turn then rallied through traffic. ON SAFARI had no speed, raced widest in the stretch and was gaining. DEMISEMIQUAVER (GB) raced in the second flight, lacked room in the second turn and did not rally. BARBETTE chased the pace off the rail but failed to sustain the bid. ROYAL LEAH set the pace in hand, led to the second turn and dropped back. QUIET QUEEN was fractious in the gate, steadied into the first turn and came up empty. LABAR flashed brief foot inside and faltered. RACE RUN IN LANE 5.
