and then from between rivals from the seven-sixteenths pole to upper stretch, was asked for a response entering the stretch, shook free before

completing the run through the furlong grounds, and drew away, being kept busy to the end. JOYFUL VICTORY reserved off the inside for the opening six furlongs, angled into the four path at the head of the stretch, was set down and rallied with good energy to garner place honors. R GYPSY GOLD three wide departing the backstretch, vied for the lead, the widest of a threesome on the turn, kept pace with other pair until

upper stretch before backing away. SALTY STRIKE tucked along rail midway down the backstretch, argued the pace with the winner, perched just to her outside, had R GYPSY GOLD join the dispute soon after entering the turn, kept up the fight until midstretch and gave way. MY ASSETS slow to settle into stride, bore out four wide after entering the turn, was flashed the whip right handed to prevent any more loss of ground, failed to reach a contending position. ALSEERA broke outward at the start, was grabbed hold, fought intensely on the bit as the rider attempted to swing the mount closer to the inside before leaving the chute, came outward several paths at a time in stages, eventually bore out to the extreme outside fence after going a quarter, was pulled up and subsequently ponied off the track.
