RISE UP broke alertly taking a slight early edge, was pressured by BISQUE down the backside and thru the quarter pole, was asked for more entering the stretch and responded to draw off in mid stretch, won convincingly being ridden out. BISQUE hustled from the gate and pressed the winner to the quarter pole, could not keep pace from upper stretch and gave chase to the wire, held well proving second best under strong encouragement. JOEDINI was off a step slow, rushed around the far turn traveling four wide, loomed off of top pair at the quarter pole, began to level off in upper stretch and was no late threat besting rest. MISTER POLLARD settled in good tracking position racing mid track, failed to respond when roused at the three eighths pole, never menaced in the lane. RUSSIAN HUMOR lacked early speed trailing down the backside, angled out five wide upper stretch, improved placing but never factored. JUST A MORGAN varied little running mid pack, put to a drive from mid turn, failed to menace. HERE COMES ALLEN flashed brief speed, retreated from mid turn, angled towards the inside top of the lane, no factor. KING HUGO lacked speed, was in tight going into the far turn racing along the rail and steadied briefly, angled out under a drive top of the lane, failed to factor.
