SILVER VALLEY broke alertly pressuring the pace putting a head in from between horses on the turn, shook clear in the two path upper stretch holding firm the final eighth. DELIVER bumped hard after the break raced five wide to the turn, responded there vying three deep to upper stretch, chased SILVER VALLEY the final eighth angling out a bit while securing place. DREAM S'MORE slow early saved ground to upper stretch responding near the rail to outbid the others. LADY RED DI bobbled then ducked in sharply leaving the gate, hustling to recover gave a mild move on the turn then leveled off in the three path late. MI PERLITA slow early gained some modest position to upper stretch proving no menace. SHEDOESITHERWAY showed early speed then retreated on the turn. CAHOKIA faded from contention on the turn. STUNNING DRAMA hustled to the early lead would work the pace along the inside, wavered into upper stretch giving way along the rail. SECONDHAND JUSTICE had brief foot then folded abruptly on the turn, was pulled up in mid stretch walking off.
