INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD FOALIED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY.* By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; A supplement nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made by Friday, June 9; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, June 3, 2006 with 27 Nominations.

SABELLINA was outrun early along the inside, trailed into the stretch, found room inside in upper stretch, rallied on the rail, altered course through traffic, finished strongly once clear outside and was along in time. FINLANDIA raced close up early while between rivals, rallied wide into the stretch, led between calls in deep stretch and dug in gamely but could not hold off the winner. RAHYS' APPEAL pressed the pace from the outside, rallied to the front in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. NURSE CULKIN was outrun early, saved ground, angled out in the stretch and finished well. THE LAMP IS LIT quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. LITTLE BUTTERCUP was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. HALF HEAVEN was rated along early, raced three wide on both turns and had no rally. SAMSINCHARGE was rated along early and had no response when roused. ITSNOTTHEMONEY was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. ELISA'S ENERGY raced very wide on the first turn, chased outside and tired in the stretch. ON THE BUS raced close up for three quarters and tired while racing in foal. LADY BI BI was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch.
