MARY'S FOLLIES stalked the pace along the inside, shifted out with a quarter to run to make her bid, kicked clear and maintained a safe advantage. KEERTANA settled in hand, came five wide to make her move, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. ROMACACA pressed the pace two wide, kept on willingly through a prolonged drive and dug in gamely to hold the show. HOT CHA CHA settled between horses while never far back, worked her way forward from between horses through the second turn, got through entering the stretch and was making up ground. BLUEGRASS PRINCESS contended between horses, shifted out four wide but went evenly through the drive. STRIKING DANCER was unhurried into stride, angled out six wide entering the lane and improved her position. MISS WORLD was hustled along in mid pack along the hedge and went evenly. SINGLE SOLUTION angled in at once to save ground, angled to the outside leaving the second turn and finished with a belated gain. KIAWAH CAT was allowed to settle, made a mild rally from between horses but came up empty entering the stretch. WAR KILL set the pressured pace along the inside, disputed the issue to final furlong and gave way. C. S. SILK was rank to place along the inside, settled into stride on the backstretch but lacked a response when called upon. REDREAMIT was hung wide throughout and was never a factor. MISS KELLER (IRE) was forwardly placed three wide, but faltered from between horses nearing the quarter pole and retreated. OBSEQUIOUS was through early.
