1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$175,000 MRS. REVERE S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$175 each or by supplementary nomination of \$8,750 each at time of entry. \$875 to pass the entry box; \$875 additional to start, with \$175,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing six th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade or Group I at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade or Group II at a mile or over on the turf in 2010, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010, 6 lbs. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, November 3, 2010 with 36 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). ARUNA settled in hand between rivals, shifted out leaving the second turn, came five wide, forged a narrow lead with a furlong to run and gamely edged clear. WILD MIA attended the pace along the inside, got through to make her bid entering the stretch, drew even with a furlong to run but was unable to match strides with the winner. FUGITIVE ANGEL tucked in to save ground, got through along the hedge leaving the second turn, shifted out between horses, quickened late and was making up ground. SNOW TOP MOUNTAIN settled between horses, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, angled out five wide and loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. STARS TO SHINE was allowed to settle, wheeled out five wide entering the stretch, but found her best stride too late. IN THE SLIPS was unhurried into stride toward the inside, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. DADE BABE opened clear to set the pace, was collared between horses nearing the quarter pole and gave way readily once headed. ICE MIST was forwardly placed three wide through the second turn and tired. LA CLOCHE raced wide throughout and was never a factor. QUIET BY SEVEN was reluctant to load, was close up three wide for a half and stopped.
