1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$175,000 *MRS. REVERE S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD.* By subscription of \$175 each or by supplementary nomination of \$8,750 each at time of entry. \$875 to pass the entry box; \$875 additional to start, with \$175,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade or Group I at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade or G roup II at a mile or over on the turf in 2011, 5 lbs. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, October 26, 2011 with 31 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). (Clear 62)

MARKETING MIX closest to the pace off the inside, challenged when ready on the second turn, drew off into the stretch when roused and stayed clear under steady urging. BIZZY CAROLINE reserved off the rail, waited around the second turn, angled to the rail once in the stretch and was gaining late. HUNGRY ISLAND unhurried for a half, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out when the runner up moved to the rail, split rivals in midstretch and rallied willingly late. SMART STING within striking distance off the inside, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. DON'T TELL SOPHIA stumbled at the start, was unhurried for a half, raced three wide on the second turn and made a solid late gain. TOURMALINE forwardly placed three wide, challenged from that path with three furlongs to go but weakened in the drive. GROUPIE DOLL outrun for a half, angled out a bit for the drive and made a late gain. HOLIDAYSTHEFARM outrun to the stretch, found her best stride too late. NEW NORMAL set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. SEA LEVEL DRIVE within striking distance, save ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. TRAC N JAM within striking distance, raced four wide midway through the second turn and tired.
