ENTERPRISING saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path, was asked at the guarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, took the lead near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. KASAQUI (ARG) raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, settled towards the back, went around the far turn in the three path, was asked near the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into the stretch then was put to a drive, rallied on the outside and closed well to just miss. OSCAR NOMINATED went three wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive near the three-sixteenths, battled determinedly in the final furlong and just missed in a three-way photo. BULLARDS ALLEY raced inside early on the first turn then moved to the two path, settled at the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive near the three-sixteenths, gained into the final furlong, moved out in the final sixteenth and finished with good energy. ONE MEAN MAN raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, took the lead at the five-sixteenths, came three wide into the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth then weakened. SPECIAL OPS went three wide on the first turn, was reserved under a strong hold, raced three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and was out-kicked. BLARP was taken in hand early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved off the pace, saved ground early on the far turn then moved to the two path, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. GRANNY'S KITTEN traveled around the first turn in the two path, was rated under a snug hold, went four wide while let out on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and tired. ROMAN APPROVAL navigated the first turn in the two path, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was shuffled back behind SKY FLIGHT coming to the guarter-pole, came under a drive near the three-sixteenths and failed to rally. PUMPKIN RUMBLE had a shoe repaired in the paddock, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under urging in the five path on the far turn, spun six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. SKY FLIGHT raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the five-sixteenths and faded.
