About 1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:47) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 Muniz Memorial H. (Grade II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 by Saturday, March 10. \$1,500 to enter, \$1,500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$8,000 will be accepted by 12:00 noon on Wednesday, March 14 which shall include all fees. \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Wednesday, March 14. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Muniz Memorial Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The winner of the 2018 Muniz Memorial Handicap (GI) will be granted an automatic berth (no fees) to the 2018 Old Forester Turf Classic (GI) and the Arlington Million (GI). Nominations Closed Saturday, March 10, 2018 with 26 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth.) (Rail at 5 feet). (Clear 78)

Chestnut Horse, (Feb), by Tapit - Brownie Points by Forest Wildcat. Trainer Michael Stidham. Bred by Pin Oak Stud, LLC (KY).

SYNCHRONY was to establish position leaving the gate, settled on the inside, angled three wide while roused at the five-sixteenths, rallied five wide into the stretch, took the lead at the three-sixteenths, shook clear into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. ARKLOW was asked leaving the gate, bumped with GALTON early, went around the first turn in the two path, settled in the front half of the field, came under urging between horses inside the seven-sixteenths, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid shortly thereafter, lost touch with the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished but came home with good courage to get the place. ZULU ALPHA bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened but just held the show. MR. MISUNDERSTOOD was hustled from the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace down the backstretch, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and was out-kicked then just missed the show. RING WEEKEND jumped the gate tracks early, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn, was carried to the four path at the five-sixteenths, rallied six wide into the stretch, made a brief bid at the three-sixteenths then tired. LUCULLAN bobbed at the start and was last to commence, went around the first turn in the three path, settled near the back, was ridden along in the three path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, shifted further out near the furlong marker, drifted in around the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. FORGE (GB) was taken in hand early, raced in the three path on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked in the three path at the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. ONE MEAN MAN moved in early, saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the two path while inside of LUCULLAN on the far turn and failed to threaten. REVVED UP raced inside to the two path on the first turn, settled at the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. GALTON bumped with a rival at the start, bumped with ARKLOW early, saved ground while off the pace, was urged along on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. DANISH DYNAFORMER went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three wide while urged along early on the far turn, was carried five wide at the five-sixteenths, floated six wide into the stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 5 Feet)
