About 1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:47<sup>4</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 Muniz Memorial H. (Grade II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 by Saturday, March 9. \$1,500 to enter, \$1,500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$8,000 will be accepted by 12:00 noon on Friday, March 15 which shall include all fees. \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Friday, March 15. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Muniz Memorial Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The winner of the 2019 Muniz Memorial Handicap (GI) will be granted an automatic berth (no fees) to the 2019 Old Forester Turf Classic (GI) and the Arlington Million (GI). Nominations Closed Saturday, March 9, 2019 with 26 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth.). (Clear 71)

BRICKS AND MORTAR broke out then was corrected by the rider, was taken under a snug hold passing the wire for the first time, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, rounded the far turn in the two path, made an outside bid while set down in upper stretch, dueled gamely with the runner-up in the final furlong, brushed with that foe in the final sixteenth and won the head-bob on the wire under strong handling. MARKITOFF rounded the first turn in the two path, was well rated while setting a tepid pace, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, dueled gamely inside of the winner, brushed with that foe in the final sixteenth and was denied while clear for the place. SYNCHRONY was taken in hand early, settled in the two path, was asked on the far turn, moved out from behind horses in upper stretch and finished with good courage for the show. DIVISIDERO was eased back off the early pace, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved at the rear, went three wide on the far turn, was roused while five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. HOT SPRINGS was taken in hand early then rated just off the pace, drafted inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, had room along the rail in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. INSPECTOR LYNLEY broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally.
