margin and kept clear to the wire. CUSHION (GB) was well reserved racing in the back of the field, given cue approaching the final turn, steadily moved into contention, split foes at the eighth pole and produced a late kick to capture place. LILBOURNE ELIZA (IRE) jostled

ANGELICA ZAPATA stalked the pace between rivals in a crowded backstretch, asked for more at the head of the lane, within contention and finished evenly in late stages. THE BLONDE PEQUE tracked the pacesetter along the rail in the backstretch, saved ground heading into the lane and failed to move on in the final furlong. MERILORE urged for response at the quarter pole, raced five wide in the final turn and finished evenly in the late drive. SHY'S ALY saved ground racing along the inside and steadily lost ground after the half. TRIPLE ARCH stalked the leader three deep in the backstretch, began to weaken approaching the final turn and had no late response. CLEARBROOK urged for

response three wide leaving the backstretch and came up empty.
