By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and \$3,500 additional to start. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided - Approximately 12.5% of gross purse August 5 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 20.5% of gross purse September 2 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 66.5% of gross purse October 14 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. Purses to be divided 60% to first, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 120 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner, Trainer and Jockey. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2003 with 137 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 12, 2006 with (851) nominations. (Cloudy 83)

Bay Filly, (Feb), by Adhocracy - Relic Rhythm by Prospector's Halo. Trainer Plesa, Jr. Edward. Bred by Centaur Farms Inc.(FL). ADHRHYTHM stalked the pace after bobbling at the start, moved to gain the lead on the backstretch, then drew off through the stretch while lugging in along the rail. SILKILY showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by ADHRHYTHM, continued on well to midway of the turn, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. SNOW LADY unhurried early, saved ground while advancing into the stretch, altered course outside SILKILY and flattened out. DANTRELLE LIGHT showed speed off the rail into the backstretch, remained in contention into the far turn, then tired. SYNERGY steadied to avoid running up on heels on the first turn, stalked the pace into the far turn and faltered. SAINT BARBARA rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and faded. BOXITUP showed some early foot, stopped and was pulled up in the stretch.
