GRAN LIONESS broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, held a comfortable advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urgin. GRANDACIOUS chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. HOLY HEAVENS unhurried early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn but could only gain the show. TENSAS PUNCH pressed the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, but had nothing left for the drive. FOREST SKY could only pass tired ones. FLASH MASH forced the early pace outside and tired. STREET STORM was never a threat. LITTLE WIDOW MAKER had little interest. DIXIELAND BULL flashed early speed and tired.
