A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 may be made at any point prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fourth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed, 2 lbs.; a race, 4 lbs.; maidens, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starters races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, September 17, 2011 with 27 Nominations. (Cloudy 64)

VEXOR broke well and assumed a forward position, pressed the pacesetter towards the two path, got set down turning for home, as did all but one member of the field, and commenced a stretch duel with TRINNIBERG, battled hard and on even terms with that opponent, began to edge away leaving the sixteenth pole, stayed under a strong drive to preserve the decision. TRINNIBERG vied for command, kept at a slight distance off the rail, turned for home with the top one still latched on to her outside and got asked for run, engaged in a spirited tussle with the eventual winner that lasted until the sixteenth pole, was shaken off at that juncture, but continued on with good courage to be second best. SEEKER under encouragement cutting the corner into the lane got out finished. JAGATI chased the front runners three wide and weakened. HANNIBAL LECTER sat under a good hold, wedged in between rivals for a good portion of the run around the bend, remained under that same good hold caught behind foes as the field headed into the stretch, had sufficient racing room a sixteenth down the road, came up empty when asked for a response. SHE DIGS ME broke alertly, pulled noticeably on the right side of the bit soon after the start, proceeded to bear out several paths, took the four path on the turn, was under a drive entering the stretch and tired.
