HEATSEEKER (IRE) chased outside, came four wide into the stretch, bid between rivals in the drive, gained he lead past midstretch and proved best under left handed urging. RACKETEER angled in and settled outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and closed willingly. ISIPINGO pulled between horses then chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch, bid between rivals in the drive and just held third. RAVEL pulled his way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. ARSON SQUAD unhurried a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and found his best stride late outside. BOLD CHIEFTAIN four wide on the first turn, stalked outside, bid three deep into the stretch, put a head in front between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. HELLO SUNDAY (FR) pulled between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WANNA RUNNER angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, continued inside in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BUZZARDS BAY chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn and lacked the needed late kick. MASTERPIECE (ARG) had speed three deep then inched away and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened.
