Bay Colt, (Mar), by Jimmy Creed - Achalaya by Bellamy Road. Trainer William I. Mott. Bred by Silver Springs Stud, LLC (KY).

CASA CREED went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, took a narrow advantage while four wide into upper stretch, battled outside of two opponents past the eighth-pole, dueled outside of the runner-up in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. SOMBEYAY saved ground under a tight hold on the first turn, prompted the pace on the inside while in hand, took the lead while let out at the five-sixteenths, came under a drive into upper stretch, battled inside of two foes past the eighth-pole, dueled with the winner in the final furlong, drifted out closer to that foe near the sixteenth-pole, fought gamely to the wire and was denied while clear for the place. GLOBAL ACCESS was put under restraint early then taken back between horses nearing the first turn, pulled while keen between horses in the two then three path on the initial bend, bumped lightly with a foe near the five-eighths, was rated off the pace while tugging at the bit, went three wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch then was put to a drive and finished willingly for the show. ENGLISH BEE jostled with foes on both sides early then was taken back, saved ground under a tight hold on the first turn then was rated on the inside, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths, came under a drive in upper stretch and gained mild ground but was out-kicked. SWAMP RAT jostled with a foe early then became rank under restraint, pulled hard under restraint in the two path on the first turn then was rated off the pace, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole then swung four wide into the stretch, passed the three-sixteenths under a drive and lacked the needed kick. AWARD WINNER was asked leaving the gate, jostled with a rival early, raced in the three path on the first turn, set the pace on the outside of an opponent, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked while being headed at the five-sixteenths, battled between horses under a drive into the final furlong then weakened. LIMONITE saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear of the field, rounded the far turn in the two path, was roused inside the five-sixteenths, moved out under a drive outside the furlong marker, shifted further out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. MOON COLONY went four wide on the first turn, bumped lightly with a foe near the five-eighths, was rated on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. (Rail at 18 Feet)
