BRICKS AND MORTAR broke in at the start, settled tracking along the inside under rating, remained patiently handled in the pocket until put to very light coaxing spinning just off the inside for home in behind foes, tipped out a path three-sixteenths from home before angling out to a clear lane near the eighth pole roused in full, offered up a good kick to overthrow the top dueling pair with seventy yards to the finish and prevailed inching away at the end kept to task. YOSHIDA (JPN) bobbled at the break, was forwardly placed in hand three wide and patiently handled tucking briefly to the two path at the seven-sixteenths before going back three wide with three furlongs to run, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home fully extended advancing to be on near even terms for command with three-sixteenths to go, dug in shaken off a bit a furlong out before dueling through the final eighth with BIG HANDSOME to his inside, got overtaken by the aforementioned foe in tandem seventy yards from the finish and battled on to win the fight for the place honors. BIG HANDSOME just off the inside in aim of the leader, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out and advanced to be the first to take a crack at SECRETARY AT WAR through the latter portion of the turn, got joined outside by the aforementioned foe and spun just off the inside for home between rivals, took over narrow command at the three-sixteenths, inched away a bit briefly before knocking heads through the final eighth with YOSHIDA to his outside, got collared by the eventual winner seventy yards from home and fought on but was just nodded for the place honors. SNAP DECISION three wide in hand in mid pack behind the cover of YOSHIDA, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled four wide at the quarter pole, ran on to secure the last major share over a late surging foe outside. MAKARIOS four then three wide in the clear in mid pack, came under coaxing with three furlongs remaining, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid closing late and just missed for the last major share. PARLOR brushed the off side stall at the start and was pinched between foes due to pressure from BONUS POINTS breaking outwards, settled three wide at the tail of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid to close ground belatedly in the drive. ARKLOW two to three wide near the rear, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. SECRETARY AT WAR established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside through sensible splits, came under light coaxing at the three-eighths as BIG HANDSOME began to advance outside, cut the corner into upper stretch under threat from a pair roused for the drive, got headed with three-sixteenths to go, weakened in the final furlong, BONUS POINTS broke out at the start and was corrected just after pinching back PARLOR, darted to the inside soon after the start before settling just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging five-sixteenths out, cornered three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened.
