the lead a sixteenth out then was lightly handled to the wire. GRAND ADVENTURE stalked from the rail, bid a furlong out and gained the lead briefly but failed to contain the winner with a sixteenth to run. FATAL BULLET forced the pace, raced on the fourth path through the turn,

chased up close into the stretch, was passed but finished gamely. FIELD COMMISSION dropped back nearing the turn, saved ground from off

the pace, got into gear at the head of the stretch but was blocked three-sixteenths out losing momentum then rallied gamely between rivals.

BRIDGETOWN dueled from the rail on the turn, was passed on his inside a furlong out then finished evenly. SNEAKING UPONYOU dueled along the third path, raced gamely into the stretch, was passed a furlong out and evened out. SIGNATURE RED raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn and launched an all out drive but failed to show a late gain. BOGUE CHITTO stalked the pacesetters, chased from

the top of the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. TOWZEE (NZ) raced midpack while two and three-wide, was hustled into the stretch, was game along the inside but showed no late gain. AMICO FRITZ (GER), in touch, raced three-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch then flattened out in the late stages. WOODBOURNE stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch but failed to respond to encouragement in the late stages. BALTHAZAAR'S GIFT (IRE) was hustled early then settled off the pace, was roused at the top of the

stretch, was under an all out drive but could not gain and tired.
