FOURSTAR CROOK settled just off the inside in mid pack of the main flight well behind the leader and closest pursuer patiently handled through to the quarter pole, angled five wide at that station set down for the drive, rallied willingly to take over command nearing the sixteenth pole, dug in and held on gamely from her late surging barnmate to prevail. SISTERCHARLIE (IRE) bumped at the start by EMPRESSOF THE NILE, settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under coaxing along the inside three furlongs from home, angled six wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final eighth surging late but missed on the wire. DADDYS LIL DARLING three wide near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, closed well down the center of the course to secure the show honors. MOM'S ON STRIKE three then two wide through the first turn, settled four wide near the rear, came under light coaxing with nine-sixteenths to go, remained in the overland route through the far turn, went eight to nine wide at the head of the stretch and kicked on belatedly to secure the last major share. HOLY HELENA tracked the pace three wide from afar among the leaders of the main flight well behind, came under coaxing just off the inside midway on the far turn, swung four wide into upper stretch, ran on through the stretch but was outkicked in the late going. FAHAN MURA lightly coaxed from the gate, spurted away in hand along the inside through swift splits, remained patiently handled awaiting the field to close in, got roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, held safe to the eighth pole before being overhauled near the sixteenth marker and weakened to the finish. EMPRESSOF THE NILE broke out at the start bumping SISTERCHARLIE, raced three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide in pursuit among the main flight leaders, got coaxed along three furlongs out, swung six wide at the quarter pole and offered no response. ESQUISSE (GB) tracked the pace along the inside isolated between the spurting leader and the main flight well behind, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up the mildest of bids gaining on the weary growing leader before flattening out through the final furlong. SNOWY WINTER tracked the pace just off the inside leading the main flight well behind the spurting leader and closest pursuer, came under coaxing tucked to the hedge three furlongs from home, swung two to three wide at the head of the stretch and came up empty.
