PERREGAUX contently rode the rail, was eased off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung from the outside into the lane and got called upon, failed to pick up ground appreciably during the initial portion of the stretch drive, left the sixteenth pole and proceeded to display strong late foot to garner place

for run turning for home as the closest pursuers prepared for their challenges, yielded just prior to reaching the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter.
