7 FURLONGS. (1.20) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 NEW YORK STALLION SERIES S. FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. For Fillies and Mares that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligib le to this race. \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 twice in 2012, 4 lbs.; a sweepstake or four races 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey . (Cloudy 47)

Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Wild Desert - Hoping for Sun by Louis Quatorze. Trainer Parisella John. Bred by Breed of Characters, LLC(NY).

SUNNY DESERT bumped soundly at the start both sides when HALDANE broke out and MAH JONG MADDNES broke inwards, got squeezed back between foes and was briefly in hand, settled unhurried in the three path, progressed four wide on the trio stacked across the track from the five-sixteenths lightly coaxed, took command straightening away four wide in upper stretch, had the rider sneak a peek back for pressure at the eighth pole, roused his charge nearing the sixteenth marker in reaction to LADY ON THE RUN progressing, drew clear in the final sixteenth under a drive, then was geared down late to score in hand. LADY ON THE RUN broke in at the start brushing JITNEY, came under light coaxing from the rear initially four wide, shifted to the rail at the half mile pole, came under rousing at the five-sixteenths, spun four to five wide in upper stretch, offered up a good kick to threaten the eventual winner a furlong out triggering that one to get more busy, proved unable to match strides through the final sixteenth while safe for the place. JITNEY away well despite being brushed at the start, settled three wide off a duel early on, ranged up at the seven-sixteenths to join the fray up front lightly coaxed, took command nearing the quarter pole and led briefly until headed straightening for home three wide, kicked on with good energy to the eighth pole before weakening late on while well clear of the rest. HALDANE broke out at the start bumping SUNNY DESERT soundly then squeezed that foe back in tandem with MAH JONG MADDNES, dueled inside for command, came under urging at the three-eighths in response to JITNEY arriving on the scene to join the battle from the seven-sixteenths, was displaced on the lead nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and tired. MAH JONG MADDNES broke in at the start bumping SUNNY DESERT and squeezed that foe out with HALDANE, dueled from the two path, came under urging three furlongs out, retreated steadily in the latter portion of the turn and folded.
