CASH INCLUDED stalked the pace outside a rival then off the rail, gained the advantage outside the pacesetter on the second turn, inched away into the stretch and drew clear under urging. POINT ASHLEY stalked three deep then outside on the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn, continued outside the winner in the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but was clearly second best. QUICK LITTLE MISS four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show. SPENDITALLBABY stalked inside then off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ADORADORA broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. BACK IN THE SHADE unhurried inside early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, then drifted inward through the lane. OUTOFTHEPAST three deep into the first turn, settled outside then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. TONJA'S WORLD pulled between foes early, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. CEST MARK saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and also weakened. SHES GOT SKILLS sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner early on the second turn, dropped back on that turn and in the stretch and gave way. PINATA settled a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch and had nothing left.
