1 1/8 MILES. (1.39) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 OAK LEAF S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$375 each if made on or before Thursday, September 22, 2011. Closed with 16. All horses shall pay \$3,750 additional to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. The Oak Leaf Stakes has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Oak Leaf Stakes will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2 011 running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Filly division. The nominated winner will be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend of \$10,000 (US) if traveling from a location in North America or \$20,000 (US) if traveling internationally. To be eligible for the 2011 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held at Churchill Downs on November 4 & 5, 2011, all horses must be pre-entered by NOON (Eastern Time at the designated pre-en try locations) on October 24, 2011. Winner must be nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 88)

WEEMISSFRANKIE chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. CANDREA had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, took the lead a quarter mile out, inched away in the stretch, kicked clear and held on well but was caught on the line. CHARM THE MAKER unseated the rider when fractious before loading, angled in and stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, lugged in some in midstretch but went on willingly between the top pair late. MY GI GI chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SELF PRESERVATION had good early speed between horses, angled in on the first turn and dueled inside, fought back leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. REGAL BETTY broke a bit awkwardly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WILD TRUFFLES angled in early and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. SILENT SAGA pulled her way along inside and steadied off heels into the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back under urging into the stretch and gave way.
