Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Indian Ridge (IRE) - Kyka by Blushing John. Trainer Hendricks L. Dan. Bred by Irish National Stud(IRE).

DAYTONA (IRE) dueled outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid alongside that one into the second turn, gained the lead, kicked clear leaving that turn, found the rail into the stretch and proved best under a crack of the whip and steady handling. TEN A PENNY settled outside a rival then inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and rallied between foes for the place. STONESIDE (IRE) steadied between horses in the run past the wire the first time, chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the show. UNUSUAL SUSPECT between rivals early, stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KARAZI (SWI) pulled early and steadied into the first turn, stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MOSTACOLLI MORT angled in and chased inside, moved up some into the stretch, was blocked and steadied off heels in midstretch, came out and lacked the needed rally.

ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. SENIOR four wide early, angled in outside a rival chasing the pace and did not rally. AUGMENT pulled early, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. ASPERITY had good early speed and dueled inside then inched away, set the pace inside, fought back into the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
