JERANIMO had speed outside a rival then took the lead inside on the first turn, stalked just off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, re-bid alongside MONTEREY JAZZ to regain the advantage in upper stretch, kicked clear under urging and held. MR. COMMONS settled a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch and finished well but could not quite catch the winner. JOHN JOHNY JAK stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and bested the others. CROWN OF THORNS chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. MONTEREY JAZZ went up three deep early, took the lead outside the winner leaving the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back into the stretch, then weakened. CALIMONCO three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
