WE'RE IN THE MONEY passed tiring rivals. SILK RIDGE chased early, bid through the second turn then gave way. FIRST IS BEST made a middle move to the stretch then came up empty. TIP TOE ANNIE raced evenly. RAPID REVOLUTION also turned in an even effort. HOT BREW was through after a half. UNCONDITIONAL showed little. BELLE CHERIE MARY chased to the quarter pole then stopped. RHAPSODY OF DREAMS showed little.
