By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination closed with 32 on Thursday July 10, 2014. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start , with \$100,000 Added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 at one mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race of \$30,000, 4 lbs. ; of such a race of \$22,000 or \$17,000 any distance, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered.) High weights, first preference; graded/group stakes placed, second preference. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. *\$50,000 to the winner. (Clear 77)

ENTERPRISING allowed to settle a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up on the wire. ARGYLE CUT saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, took the lead outside the pacesetter past midstretch, inched away but was caught late. HOME SCHOOL (IRE) sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn and into the stretch, fought back past midstretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. SAMMY MANDEVILLE broke through the gate before the start, angled in and settled a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. G. G. RYDER pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, bid a bit off the rail on the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn and weakened some in the stretch. LOVE RULES ALL also pulled early and pressed the pace outside a rival or three deep, continued just off the rail leaving the second turn and also weakened some in the drive. FOREVER JUANITO chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TEXAS RYANO angled in and settled just off the rail then chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, drifted out in midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. AOTEAROA pushed open the door on the gate but did not come out, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. PATRIOTS RULE settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in midstretch and was not a threat. MAJESTIC KITTEN saved ground chasing the pace and weakened in the stretch. A claim of foul by the trainer of PATRIOTS RULE against the winner for alleged interference in midstretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled TEXAS RYANO was the cause of the trouble and disqualified that runner and placed him tenth.
