1 MILE. (Turf) (1:32) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 (Includes \$2,070 Other Sources. Pluses \$2,070 Other Sources.) Oceanside S.FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS, NON-WINNERS OF A SWEEPSTAKES OF \$50,000* AT ONE MILE OR OVER IN 2016. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination closed July, 7 with 34 nominations or by supplementary nomination of \$1,000 each by closing time of entries, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Weight 124 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 at one mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race of \$30,000, 4 lbs.; of such a race of \$22,000 or \$17,000 any distance, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered.) High weights, first preference; graded/group stakes placed, second preference. Total earnings in non-claiming races in 2016 will be used in determining the preference of horses with equal weights. STARTERS TO BE NAMED THROUGH THE ENTRY BOX TUESDAY, JULY 12 BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. **\$50,000 to the winner. *Number next to horse name is preference order*. (Clear 77)

Bay Gelding, (Mar), by Hat Trick (JPN) - Aunt Bea by Elusive Quality. Trainer Peter Miller. Bred by Robert B. Trussell Jr. (KY).

MONSTER BEA angled in and chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn, came six wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead past midstretch and won clear. MOONLIGHT DRIVE (ITY) stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the lead, inched away nearing midstretch, could not hold the winner but saved the place. PATH OF DAVID chased between horses then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and just held third. DRESSED IN HERMES allowed to settle outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. ARCATURE chased three deep then angled in off the rail, went three wide into the stretch and between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. DIPLODOCUS saved ground stalking the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, continued inside and also was outfinished. MISHEGAS angled in and settled inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MR. ROARY angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. IMPERIOUS ONE (IRE) had good early speed and dueled inside a rival but a bit off the rail to the stretch, was between horses past midstretch and also weakened. EBADAN (IRE) angled in and chased outside a rival then inside, came out around rivals into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in traffic past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. HOLLYWOOD DON angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, fell back some leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
