1 1/4 MILE. (1:47.2) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 Ohio Derby FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. No Nomination Fee by Wednesday June 14, 2017. Supplementary Nominations accepted to the Ohio Derby of \$1,250 due by Monday June 19, 2017. \$600 to enter and \$550 additional to Start with a purse of \$500,000, of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; and 2% to sixth. Weight: 126 lbs. Non-Winners of a Grade 1 Stake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs; Non-Winners of Grade 2 Stake at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over since December 24, 2016 allowed 6 lbs; (Maiden, Claiming, Optional, and Starter races not considered in weight allowances). The Ohio Derby will be limited to Fourteen (14) Starters. In the event more than Fourteen (14) Entries pass through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Wednesday, June 21, 2017. Preference will be given to (1) Grade/Group 1 winners; (2) Grade/Group 2 winners and Grade/Group 1 place finishers; (3) Grade/Group 3 winners and Grade/Group 2 place finishers; (4) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Lifetime Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. A Trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer, and Jockey. (Clear 76)

IRAP steadied behind rivals entering the clubhouse turn, remained in tight while between foes entering the backstretch, was patiently handled into the second turn, rallied steadily three wide, dug in determinedly despite being bumped by GIRVIN in deep stretch and got up in the final stride. GIRVIN pressed the pace three wide early, made the lead just before the second turn, dueled into the stretch, shook clear, drifted out late under left handed urging and just missed hanging on. UNTRAPPED broke outward bumping TALK LESS at the start, was always within striking distance, offered a bid four wide into the stretch then was outfinished. SORRY ERIK never far back, offered a mild bid along the rail into the stretch then leveled off. GAME OVER unhurried early, loomed boldly nearing the three eighths pole while two wide then came up empty. HINTON stalked the pace from the four path early and was through after six furlongs. TALK LESS was bumped at the start then no factor. VIBE pressed the pace two wide around the first turn, dropped back a bit, came on again between horses before the far turn, had speed into the stretch then stopped. FAST AND ACCURATE made the lead shortly after the start, set the pace under pressured for a little over a half then folded. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
