OM dueled inside, inched away on the turn, got clear leaving the bend, drifted out from the left handed whip in the stretch and drew off. IRON FIST off a bit slowly, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive but gained the place. ONE LUCKY DANE saved ground chasing the pace, waited off heels then split rivals in midstretch and got up for third. CALCULATOR broke a bit slowly, settled inside, split horses leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for the show. AMERICAN PHAROAH unsettled in the post parade and warm up, dueled three deep then outside the winner, stalked off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. DADDY D T four wide early, chased outside a rival, went three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SCORPIOUS dueled between horses on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and weakened. LITIGATION ROAD allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the turn and lacked a further response. MILTEE a bit slow into stride, settled off the inside then angled to the fence on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail.
