1st MILES. (.00) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 (US \$178,920) *ONTARIO DERBY(GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$200 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$2,000 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non- winners of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at a mile or over in 2006, 5 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over in 2006, 7 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$4,000 which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$12,420 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Closed Wednesday, September 13, 2006 with 15 nominations. (Cloudy 15)

ROYAL CHALLENGER rated off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn and finished gamely in vain. STORM CALLER rated early, closed three-deep on the far turn and finished all out. PORTS N PORSCHEs raced midpack, saved ground, was hustled through the far turn then finished gamely to no avail. OH SO AWESOME broke in the air, remained unhurried to the stretch then passed the tired early pacesetter. STRADIVINSKY took an easy lead, raced well off the rail, widened on the backstretch then tired on the far turn.
