1 MILE. (Turf) (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *OUIJA BOARD DISTAFF H. (GRADE III) (PLUS UP TO \$15,750 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* \$20,000 to third, \$11,500 to fourth and \$5,500 to fifth and \$3,000 for placing sixth through tenth. If less than ten horses start, the purse money not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weights: Three Year Olds, 115 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 on the turf since November 25, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 since November 25, 2009, 5 lbs.; \$20,000 since January 25, 2010, 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2009-2010 as determined by Equibase Company will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.). (Clear 87)

Dark Bay or Brown Mare, (Feb), by Najran - Wishes and Roses by Greinton (GB). Trainer Evans B. Bart. Bred by Bart Evans (KY). WASTED TEARS contested the pace on the outside through quick fractions, led into the final furlong and held gamely under right hand urging. FORTUNIA was reserved while a bit rank, moved out nearing the quarter-pole, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but missed. BUBBLER contested the pace on the inside, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished while able to hold the show. THE CAT WHO was rated just behind the leaders, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. LOVE TO TELL was reserved on the inside, ranged up on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. SLIDE ON BYE settled on the outside, raced three to four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. (Rail at 0 Feet)
