1¹ MILES. (2:07¹) STAKES. Purse \$1,000,000 *PACIFIC CLASSIC S. (GRADE I)* FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each to accompany the nomination. The Pacific Classic has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The winner of the Pacific Classic will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2008 running of the Breeders' Cup Classic, subject to the payment of all pre-entry, entry and supplementary (if applicable) fees. To be eligible for the 2008 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita Park on October 24-25, 2008. All applicable fees shall accompany the pre-entry. All horses shall pay \$1,000 to enter and \$9,000 additional to start, with \$1,000,000 Guaranteed, of which \$600,000 to the winner, \$200,000 to second, \$120,000 to third, \$60,000 to fourth and \$20,000 to fifth. Three-year-olds, 117 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. This race will not be divided. Preference will be given Graded or Group Stakes winners in 2008. Second preference will be given to those horses with the highest total earnings from Graded or Group races since July 18, 2007. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Nominations closed Thursday, August 14, 2008, with 23. (Clear 76)

GO BETWEEN angled in and settled inside then off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch, then gamely prevailed. WELL ARMED stalked off the rail then outside a rival, took the lead three deep a quarter mile out, inched away in the stretch, fought back inside the winner in the final furlong and continued gamely to the end. MAST TRACK three deep early, stalked outside a rival, continued off the inside leaving the second turn, was three deep into the stretch and between rivals in midstretch and bested the others. ZAPPA chased inside, came out for room leaving the second turn, was in tight between horses into the stretch, went around a rival, continued inside and put in a late bid at a minor award. STUDENT COUNCIL angled in outside a rival early, pulled his way along a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went between foes and was in a bit tight early on the second turn, continued three deep into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. SURF CAT prompted the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, bid again along the fence leaving the second turn and weakened some in the stretch. AWESOME GEM settled inside then between foes on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MOSTACOLLI MORT broke slowly, settled inside then off the rail, went three deep nearing the second turn, continued off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. DELOSVENTOS close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes on the second turn and weakened. BARCOLA had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then inched away a bit off the rail, battled briefly between horses a quarter mile out and had little left for the stretch.
