DULLAHAN settled outside or alongside a rival, moved up three and four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging while drifting in some to wear down the runner-up late. GAME ON DUDE a step slow into stride and crowded at the start and again in the opening strides, went up three deep to stalk the pace, bid alongside the leader on the backstretch and gained the advantage nearing the half mile pole, kicked clear on the second turn, remained clear off the rail in midstretch, continued under urging as the rider lost the left rein in deep stretch and went on gamely to the wire but could not hold off the winner. RICHARD'S KID bobbed and was squeezed at the start, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again on the second turn, waited off heels just past midway on that turn, got through along the rail into the stretch, remained inside and picked up the show. RAIL TRIP came off the inside in the run to the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep, moved up some on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. SUGGESTIVE BOY (ARG) pulled between horses then stalked between foes or off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AMANI (CHI) saved ground chasing the pace, came out some on the backstretch, went between foes into and on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and did not rally. JAYCITO off a bit slowly, went three deep into the first turn then settled outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. WHERE'S STERLING between horses early, angled in on the first turn and saved ground, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. AKKADIAN pulled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back between rivals on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. RIVETING REASON broke in then came in some in the opening strides, sped to the front and angled to the inside, set the pace along the rail, dueled on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
