About 1 MILE. (Turf) (1.352) STAKES. Purse \$60,000 PAGO HOP S. FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. No nomination fee. \$300 to pass the entry box; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth; 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$25,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since July 5, 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; \$15,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since then allowed 4 lbs. \$18,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2010 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. (High Weights Preferred). Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, November 20, 2010, with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.). (Cloudy 75)

Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Feb), by Broken Vow - Valley Fever by Peaks and Valleys. Trainer Carroll Josie. Bred by Darrell Brown & Lundy Brown(KY).

VALLI WITH A VOW raced three to four wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, waited patiently while three wide on the far turn, was guided out in upper stretch, closed fast between rivals to get the lead then powered clear under strong handling. SILVER LA BELLE went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, led into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. CAMINADORA broke a bit slow, raced four to five wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, went four to five wide on the far turn, closed well in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. BATTLE BUSTER raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled towards the front of the field, went five wide on the far turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong then weakened. THE RUMOR'S TRUE raced towards the front of the field, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, dropped behind several rivals entering the stretch and lacked the needed response. ICE MIST quickly took the lead, went three wide on the first turn, set the clear pace while under restraint, went three to four wide on the far turn, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and gave way. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE broke a bit slow, lingered well back in the field and also improved position. SOMME settled in the middle of the field while off the rail, moved in a bit while caught behind traffic at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. MILLENNIA went three wide on the first turn, raced in the front half of the field, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty. KITTY LOVE settled on the inside, lost position on the far turn, dropped towards the rear of the field and had no response. DOE RUN broke a bit slow, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. STAGE MAGIC raced five then four wide on the first turn, moved in while off the pace, dropped to the rail on the far turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but had nothing left. FORTY NINE SOX broke outward at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, followed the leader from second, chased that rival on the far turn and tired. CAVE CREEKER raced towards the rear while near the inside and failed to threaten. (Rail at 0 Feet)
