RAISE THE HOOF quickly sprinted clear, set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, drifted out some in the final furlong but proved best under left handed urging. REASON TO STUDY broke in a bit and bumped a foe, chased outside then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and was clearly second best. WESTERN SHOWDOWN chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, remained along the fence in the stretch and just held third. ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN was in a good position chasing the winner between horses to the stretch and was edged for the show. B. B.'S BANDMAN broke slowly and a bit awkwardly, saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. OSO SMART settled outside then three deep into the turn, angled in alongside a rival on the turn, drifted to the inside in the stretch and weakened. GRAND PULPIT broke a bit slowly and was bumped, pulled his way between horses and steadied when racing greenly into the turn, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
