MANICERO vied for the lead from the outset, drifted a bid into the stretch, shook clear in the furlong grounds then lasted late under strong handling. BERT B DON stalked the pace outside, bid three wide into the stretch, held on well when the winner shook clear in the drive then came back on again but couldn't get up. DEPECHE CHAT was hung six wide to the turn, angled in after a half then angled back out four wide for the drive and finished willingly outside late. READ THE CONTRACT was hustled along behind the leaders, was in striking distance a furlong out but lacked a strong late response. IMPERIAL CZAR advanced to mid stretch then weakened. RIBO BOBO was fractious in the gate, broke slow then raced evenly thereafter. PORCINI PRINCE was no factor. BROCK N ROCK was used up disputing the pace.
