GOLDCENTS was sent between horses then angled in, set the pace along the inside, inched away into the turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, kicked clear, drifted out a bit and proved best under some urging and steady handling late. FED BIZ had good early speed and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and was second best. SILENTIO chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and held third. SYNDICATED chased just off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and was outfinished for the show. COLOR OF COURAGE dropped back and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG MACHER stalked the pace between horses, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. INDEXICAL close up stalking the winner three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn, was between horses in midstretch and also weakened.
