1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 PEBBLES S. FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstakes on the turf in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake on the turf or a sweepstake on the turf in 2013, 4 lbs.; a Sweepstake on the turf at any time or two races on the turf, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and restricted allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, September 28, 2013 with 42 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 66)

Gray or Roan Filly, (Apr), by Discreet Cat - To Marquet by Marquetry. Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Patricia Generazio(NY). DISCREET MARQ away in good order, sat patiently parked out in the three path for nearly three-quarters, ranged up and challenged for command as the field headed into the stretch, battled her way to a sliver of a lead by the eighth pole, edged away from a resolute foe thereafter to prove best. TAPICAT the leader for a good portion on the elbow chute, was allowed to ease back, was patiently handled while prompting the pacesetter, placed just off that one's hind quarters, moved when ready to grab a narrow advantage coming to the end of the bend, entered the stretch and was asked for her best, with the eventual winner slightly to the outside and also getting asked for some run at that stage, yielded reluctantly by the conclusion of the run through the furlong grounds, fought with vigor to the end but had to settle for being second best. TEEN PAULINE was brushed at the start, tracked the front runners from the pocket, pulling hard on the bit for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, abandoned the inside route in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch three wide, proved no match for the top twosome. FREGE travelled three wide for the opening three-quarters, swung six wide into the stretch, got straightened away and mustered up a mild response to take the last major check. DAUPHINE RUSSE (FR) in sharply after the gate was sprung open, made light contact with TEEN PAULINE, raced from between rivals around the full turn, spun into the stretch being five wide, had no rally. WITH SUGAR ON TOP saved ground until the quarter pole, made no impact. MARIEL N KATHY was lightly urged to grab the advantage away from the runner up during the very earliest stages, was yet again placed to some to some light hand urging while getting chased on the turn, yielded a short distance from the quarter pole and steadily backed away.
