BRICKS AND MORTAR away in good order and gained contending position going by wire for first time, raced two wide and steadied slightly late first turn, settled being rated three wide sitting in position near mid-pack through backstretch, came under mild rousing and loomed up closer three wide late final turn, hit top stretch and given cue, came under strong left handed drive, reach group of leaders and dug in gamely, kicked by to clear command and finished going away. MAGIC WAND (IRE) broke readily and reined back into tracking position, bit keyed up but remained under rider's command racing under snug hold through first turn, continued rated and raced off top two flights going by half mile marker, made two wide move near quarter pole, roused up into closer contention then continued steady bid under strong ride into stretch, raced in contention driving two path in final sixteenth, no late match for winner but dug in determinedly to capture place. DELTA PRINCE under firm rating going by wire for first time, unhurried racing near rear in opening quarter, steadily advanced closer contention through backstretch, roused forward reaching leader turning for home, dueled for lead with DELTA PRINCE upper stretch, no match when winner kicked by final furlong, dug back in and just missed place. CATAPULT was unhurried out of gate then grew keen under snug hold and made mid-race tugging way up to lead, continued on top and appeared comfortable through final turn, challenged by DELTA PRINCE turning for home then outfinished when winner shot by and had no kick left late reserve. CHANNEL MAKER got in tight behind rival and forced to check late first, raced off the pace through backstretch, roused four wide gaining position in final turn, kept on with interest racing four to five wide in stretch but lacked needed kick for serious impact. YOSHIDA (JPN) unhurried raced along outside early stages, dropped closer inside late backstretch, hustled up three to four wide in final turn, kept under steady encouragement racing five to six wide in stretch, gained position but needed more to pose a serious threat. NEXT SHARES steadied late first turn, settled along inside through backstretch, switched out at quarter pole, roused three wide into stretch and failed to kick on. DUBBY DUBBIE tracked the pace racing in second flight mid-backstretch, sent after leader racing three wide in final turn, gained closer contention then retreated in stretch. AEROLITHE (JPN) raced in stalking position racing second flight mid-way through backstretch, tapped on shoulder to pick up pace near three eighths pole, could not advance position then steadied while weakening through final turn. FAHAN MURA saved ground leading way in first turn, conceded position to tugging CATAPULT in early backstretch, continued forwardly positioned then could not keep pace, steadied while weakening in final turn.
