

ELEVENTH RACE **Parx Racing** **September 25th, 2010**

1½ MILES. (1.47) STAKES. Purse \$1,000,000 *PENNSYLVANIA DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$1,000 each which should accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Winners of a Grade I race at a mile or over in 2010 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2010, 5 lbs; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2010, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Monday, September 20, 2010. Nominations closed Saturday, September 4, 2010 with 28. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Clear 78)

MORNING LINE raced well reserved off the rail to set the pace, was pressured into the final turn, contested a slim advantage through the turn, dropped back a head from the top of the stretch but dug in under a hard drive to recover control and inch ahead the closing yards. **FIRST DUDE** stalked the pace about the three path, threatened the winner into the final turn, stayed between horses through the turn, was shut off at the top of the lane, continued pursuit while being eased out in deep stretch and finished strong for place. **A LITTLE WARM** rated just off the pace about the four path, started his dive past the three eighths pole, was at even terms four wide nearing the quarter pole, dueled with a slim advantage from the head of the lane, grudgingly relented in the final yards and was outfinished for place approaching the wire. **EXHI** rated just off the pace toward the inside, advanced toward contention along the rail on the final turn, angled to the outside at the top of the stretch though had little response from there. **AFLEET AGAIN**, unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, had no rally. **SEVERE WEATHER** raced well back and was never in contention.
