1½ MILES. (1.47) STAKES. Purse \$1,000,000 *PENNSYLVANIA DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$250 each if made on or before Tuesday, July 8, 2014 or \$1,000 each if made on or before Monday, September 1, 2014, \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. All horses that start in this race that which have won the Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes, Belmont Stakes, Haskell Invitational or Travers will qualify the owner and trainer to receive \$50,000 additional. Weight 122 lbs. Winners of a Grade I race at a mile or over in 2014 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2014, 5 lbs; This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early Nominations closed Tuesday, July 8, 2014 with 36. Late Nominations closed Monday, September 1, 2014 with 3. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Clear 68)

BAYERN took the lead at once and was angled to the rail, set the pace under light rating, began to edge away nearing the stretch, GARCIA changed his hold of the reins and roused BAYERN sharply left handed entering the stretch, Garcia switched to right handed pressure and BAYERN responded eagerly, opening up a long lead near the furlong marker and then he continued to draw out and in doing so, set a new track record for 1 & 1/8 miles. TAPITURE was rated just off the pace while racing in the three path, moved out wider when launching his rally racing into the stretch but was unable to sustain his bid. CANDY BOY, reserved early while saving ground, angled out when starting his rally after six furlongs, drifted out through the stretch under steady left handed pressure and gained the show spot. NOBLE MOON saved ground while never far back, failed to offer a serious challenge and finished in a dead heat with C J'S AWESOME. C J'S AWESOME raced outside of CALIFORNIA CHROME, remained a factor between foes until early stretch, tired and finished on even terms with NOBLE MOON. CALIFORNIA CHROME broke sharply, was taken in hand and saved ground while just off the pace, ESPINOSA roused CALIFORNIA CHROME sharply left handed entering the stretch, CALIFORNIA CHROME failed to respond and was being eased up through the final sixteenth. PROTONICO was outside and just off the pace, dropped back steadily. CLASSIC GIACNROLL raced two wide and failed to menace.
