

TENTH RACE Parx Racing September 19th, 2015

1¹/₂ MILE. (1:50) STAKES. Purse \$1,000,000 Pennsylvania Derby FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each on or before Saturday September 5 2015, Supplemental nominations of 10,000 due at time of entry. \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. All horses that start in this race that which have won the Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes, Belmont Stakes, Haskell Invitational or Travers will qualify the owner and trainer to receive \$50,000 additional. Weight 122 lbs. Winners of a Grade I race at a mile or over in 2015 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2015, 5 lbs; This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Saturday September 5, 2015 with 23. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Gray or Roan Colt, (Apr), by Tapit - Fast Cookie by Deputy Minister. Trainer Kieran P. McLaughlin. Bred by Darley (KY).

FROSTED was a bit crowded after start and was steered to the inside, raced just off the pace under rating, bided his time waiting for racing room leaving the backstretch, was steered to the outside and raced three wide into stretch, took the lead without need of coaxing in early stretch and drew off under a strong hand ride. IRON FIST was fanned in a bit after the start and then was eased to the outside soon after, stalked the pace outside of MR. Z, took the lead on the final turn, fought gamely when challenged by winner, was unable to match strides but was clearly second best. TOMMY MACHO raced very wide into and rounding the first turn, gradually moved closer to rail, swung to the outside when launching his bid near stretch but quickly flattened out. MR. Z broke sharply and was steered to the rail, set the pace inside, offered little resistance when challenged and dropped back steadily. UPSTART was wide and just off the early pace, tired. WAR STORY broke slowest, raced very wide while outrun and passed tiring foes. MADEFROMLUCKY, racing well off the rail while void of early speed, was never a serious threat. ISLAND TOWN, lapped on winner early, remained wide and tired. BATTLE MIDWAY raced wide and dropped back steadily.
