IRON FIST was fanned in a bit after the start and then was eased to the outside soon after, stalked the pace outside of MR. Z, took the lead on the final turn, fought gamely when challenged by winner, was unable to match strides but was clearly second best. TOMMY MACHO raced very wide into and rounding the first turn, gradually moved closer to rail, swung to the outside when launching his bid near stretch but quickly flattened out. MR. Z broke sharply and was steered to the rail, set the pace inside, offered little resistance when challenged and dropped back steadily. UPSTART was wide and just off the early pace, tired.
