 OSCAR PERFORMANCE broke alertly and retained the advantage, glided over to the rail early on the clubhouse bend, showed the way shadowed by SECRETARY OF WAR out in path two, got turned loose coming to the quarter pole, dug in well to stay in the clear. GOOD SAMARITAN strung out three wide on the first turn, was closer to rail on the backstretch, loosely drafting behind some opponents, was let out a notch coming to the conclusion of the backstretch, scurried into contention with a four wide run on the far turn, swung into the lane as the widest of a foursome and took off in earnest after the winner, failed to dent into the margin, but held late to preserve the place. TICONDEROGA took up the chase at or near the two path, was asked to pick it up coming to the five-sixteenths marker, stepped into the lane and responded when put to yet stronger handling, was taken in hand altering course into path five with approximately a sixteenth to go, to fully clear several foes directly up ahead, finished with a flourish en route for the show. BOWIES HERO kept watch on the front runners from the pocket, had a brief wait coming to the quarter pole, angled into the two path at the head of the stretch and was switched over to a drive, shifted back over to the rail a short distance later, lacked a solid closing punch. MUGGSAMATIC took up position in the two path in midpack after the start, went about the second bend from the three path, got called upon for the drive home and had no rally. MAKARIOS was quickly tucked along the rail, saved ground to the quarter pole, was urged four wide into the lane, made no impact. SECRETARY AT WAR accompanied the winner from the two path to the head of the stretch and gave way.
