SWEET VICTORY came well out from the rail while unhurried on the backstretch, was sent up three wide on the final turn, vied outside before seven furlongs then drove clear through the final sixteenth. PRICEDTOPERFECTION was unhurried inside, began her rally on the final turn, came out between rivals for the drive and gained slowly to the end. INVOLUNTARY stalked the early leader in the two path, was sent after that one nearing the quarter pole, took over entering the stretch, ducked in sharply at the eighth pole causing CONQUEST SERENADE to clip heels, then gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry, INVOLUNTARY was disqualified and placed fifth. OUTSIDER ART came well out into the course on the backstretch, raced widest around the final turn, edged closer into the final furlong then flattened out. LOTTIE angled sharply to the rail soon after the break, trailed into the stretch, had to angle out sharply in early stretch and couldn't catch up. CONQUEST SERENADE made the early pace under confident rating along the rail, gave way leaving the final turn then was impeded entering the final furlong, clipped heels and fell then quickly got up and was walked off by the rider, apparently in good condition.
