By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$10,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 twice in 2006 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 4, 2006 with 26 nominations. (Clear 51)

MIDNIGHT LUTE, in hand early while in behind rivals three or four wide, came out to rally from between foes six wide into the stretch, reached the front right at the eighth pole and drew off under strong handling. **LEWIS MICHAEL**, always well placed and five wide, came a bit wider into the upper stretch to reach the front between calls, was headed by the winner at the furlong pole and not a match for that one thereafter while clearly superior to the rest. **COURT FOLLY**, outrun four wide for five furlongs, circled horses ten wide into the lane was all out for third position. **HIGH FINANCE**, outrun early and six wide, improved position in the late going while never a threat to the top two. **PRAYING FOR CASH**, within striking distance and six wide much of the way, inched closer in the upper stretch but failed to continue the move. **SAILORS SUNSET** bobbled lightly at the start, raced four or five wide within easy striking distance to the stretch and came up empty. **REIGNING COURT** attended the pace from between rivals, reached the front between calls approaching the final quarter but weakened when straightened for the drive. **MACH RIDE** gained a slim lead early, raced near the inside, battled forwardly for five furlongs and weakened. **LATENT HEAT** tracked the pace five wide, continued up close to the final quarter and weakened. **LIKELY** raced in contention near the inside to the head of the stretch and flattened out. **FABLED** raced between rivals four wide and tired early.
